Field Camp

Properties of the Oil and Gas producing Woodford Shale, OK

- Devonian-Missippian rocks
- Source rocks for oil and gas
- Hypothesis: deep water deposits with fluctuating continental sediment input (U-Th)
- Radioactive – uranium-rich
- Extends from Pennsylvania to Texas
